#### **Quick Data from CARE Project survey:**

- 74% of people ages 24 and under feel that it is important to preserve the Vietnamese culture.
- 53% of those with at least a Bachelor's degree feel that the universities in Seattle are "above average"!
- 95% of those ages 51+ feel that Vietnamese people should interact more with those outside of the Vietnamese community.
